40	<u>Proposal</u>	to consider an invitation to join the North Huntingdon and St. Ives Cumulative Impacts Group. The group whose aims are to provide residents across our communities with access to clear, factual information about the emerging Local Plan and the potential cumulative impacts of large-scale development proposals.

a)	<u>The Lattenburys proposed development</u> <u>Consider and respond to a letter received from a parishioner.</u>	The concern is with regard to the proposed new village access from the A1307. It appears that the developers are proposing a new roundabout. The A1307 has been downgraded from a trunk road, following the opening of the new A14 Huntingdon bypass. However, the amount of traffic using the A1307 has increased from a trickle when the new road first opened to a regular busy flow. A new roundabout would cause long tailbacks particularly at peak hours. This will affect all users of the A1307 but will be especially inconvenient for residents of Hemingford Abbots.
b)	<u>New</u> <u>26/80125/COND 6 River Meadow Hemingford Abbots Huntingdon PE28 9AY.</u>	Proposal: Details submitted to discharge conditions 4 (Materials), 8 (Tree Protection Plan), 9 (Obscure Glazing), 12 (Levels) and 13 (Hard and Soft Landscaping) of planning permission reference 24/00884/FUL. For I/O - HAPC has not been asked to comment.

c)	<u>Refused</u> 26/00598/OUT 5 Common Lane Hemingford Abbots Huntingdon PE28 9AN. Proposal: Outline application for the erection of 2 dwellings. Decision Issued Date Fri 22 May 2026.
